

The Billie Jean King Cup Nations Ranking system was updated in 2020 in order to reflect the new format of the competition.

The new system is based on the existing rankings but has been adapted to accommodate the new format of the competition. This system aims to ensure that the points are fairly distributed to nations no matter the level of the competition or how many ties a nation plays in a year.

The new Billie Jean King Cup Nations Ranking will be officially published following Billie Jean King Cup weeks in the calendar and will continue to be based on results over a four-year period, with recent performances weighted more heavily.

New system explained

DEFINITIONS

T = Total ranking points for a Nation (sum of discounted single-year points)

P_{YEAR} = Total ranking points earned by a Nation within a specific single-year.

S = Stage points

W = Win bonus

R = Rank bonus

A = Away bonus
